Sat. Sept 19, 2 pm – Leonne Tanis, CNM, WHNP-BC: a midwife and reproductive health nurse practitioner in New York City who identifies as a Black, Haitian-American lesbian; formerly on the board of National Association to Advance Black Birth (NAABB)

Wed. Sept 23, 7 pm -- Tina Rosenberg, the co-founder of Solutions Journalism, which supports the global coverage of today's environmental challenges through solutions-based reporting; former NY Times writer, winner of Pulitzer Prize and National Book Award

Fri. Sept 25, 7 pm -- Lynn M. Paltrow, a lawyer and founder of Pregnancy Justice (formerly called National Advocates for Pregnant Women), which advances and defends the rights of pregnant people, now an activist with Beacon for Democracy

Sun. Sept 27, 2 pm – Dr. Jacqui Patterson, founder of The Chisholm Legacy Project, which works with Black women on the frontlines of climate justice (including in Sandbranch, Texas); former director of the NAACP Environmental and Climate Justice program; Time Magazine Woman of the Year in 2024.

Thurs. Oct 1, 7 pm – Margie Kelly, Strategic Communications Manager with the Natural Resources Defense Council in Chicago, formerly a media manager with Safer Chemicals, Healthy Families; the Breast Cancer Fund; the Center for Reproductive Rights, and an activist with Greenpeace; lead consultant to *ReproEco: Tomorrow Is Now*.
